



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

MAZDA MX-5 CLUB OF NSW MOTORKHANA

- 1. Authority:** The Event is held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Supplementary Regulations or Bulletins which may be issued. This Event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia's Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Integrity Policies, Legal Policies, Risk Management Policies, Safety 1st Framework and any other relevant Policy.

This Event will be known as **Club Motorkhana – Round 2** hereafter referred to as The Event.

- 2. Motorsport Australia Permit No 226/1207/02**

The Motorsport Australia Permit will be displayed at the start of The Event.

- 9. Entry Fee:** \$80.00 for MX-5 Club Members, \$110.00 for Non-Members, Juniors \$40.00

10. Entries:

- a) Maximum number of entries for The Event: 40 Reserves: 5
- b) Maximum number of Drivers per vehicle is two. (2)
- c) Opening Date: Sunday 7 June 2026
- d) Closing Date: 5:00 pm Tuesday 7 July 2026
- e) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and must be lodged via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system along with payment of the appropriate fee by online credit card payment or by a direct deposit to the Organising Club.
- f) Entries from people under 18 years of age must be counter-signed/consented by a Parent or Legal Guardian.
- g) If an entrant advises the Event secretary that he/she is unable to attend The Event, the following procedure regarding a refund applies: **at the Organiser discretion.**
- h) Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.
- i) Competitors submitting entries for The Event are attesting that they are either the legal owner of the vehicle they have specified on their entry form, or that they have formal permission from the legal owner to compete in the vehicle in The Event. The Mazda MX-5 Club of NSW Inc accepts no responsibility for the verifying the ownership of any vehicle entered into a motorsport event conducted by the Club

11. Tests:

As per the current Motorsport Australia Motorkhana Tests Handbook. Drivers will be advised of the selected tests via email before the Event.

12. Minimum licences:

Competitors must have a current and valid Speed/Speed Junior Competition Licence or superior

All drivers must have a current membership with a Motorsport Australia affiliated club.

Motorsport Australia Introductory Licence will be available for The Event.

Licence currency and club membership will be verified electronically prior to The Event. There will be no face-to-face registration for The Event on the day.

13. Driver Safety:

- a) Other than during competition on the competition surface, vehicle speed is to be no more than walking pace at The Event venue.
- b) Any driver whose driving behaviour during competition is judged to be dangerous by officials may be excluded from further participation in The Event.
- c) All apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual:
 - 1. Minimum of short sleeve shirt/t-shirt and short pants.
 - 2. Enclosed shoes (thongs, open sandals, and high-heeled shoes are forbidden).
 - 3. A helmet is not mandatory except for Drivers of Motorkhana Specials. If a helmet is worn, it is required to meet the Motorsport Australia Manual Schedule D and AS1698 standard.

14. Juniors:

Junior Drivers (i.e. under 16 years of age as of the date of The Event) will be required to carry a Parent or Guardian as a Passenger until Event officials are satisfied with their driving capabilities. That Parent or Guardian must be the person who signed giving consent for the Junior on their Motorsport Australia Disclaimer Form. **Refer to Clause 27 of these Supplementary Regulations for more information on passengers.**

- 15. Vehicle Check Requirements Basic vehicle safety check:**
- a) All vehicles shall comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual t.
 - b) Vehicles to be in a roadworthy condition.
 - c) Maximum noise limit: 95 dba at 30 metres.
Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from The Event until the Clerk of the Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.
 - d) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- 16. Scrutiny Check:**
The Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance must be read and accepted as part of your entry process through the Event Entry Portal.
Please note that scrutineers will conduct spot checks throughout the day.
- 17. Drivers Briefing:**
There will be a short pre-event drivers briefing at 8:45am in front of the shelter shed beside the skidpan. Comprehensive drivers briefing notes will also be distributed electronically to competitors prior to The Event.
- 18. Event Schedule:** Start time: **9.00 am** Finish time: **4:00 pm.**
- 19. Authority of Officials:**
Any Competitor not following a reasonable instruction by an official during The Event may be excluded from The Event.
The Clerk of the Course is the Judge of Fact and the facts subject to judgement are contained in the Supplementary Regulation, and any Further Regulations.
- 20. Insurance:**
Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.
- 21. Protests:**
Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- 22. Cancellation:**
The Organisers reserve the right to postpone or stop The Event in accordance with the NCR.
- 23. Integrity:**
Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.
Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.
Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
- 24. Refreshment facilities:**
Available at venue.
- 25. Additions and/or alterations:**

Any additions and/or alterations to these Supplementary Regulations will be notified to all entrants in Final Regulations or via email prior to The Event.

26. Vehicles:

Open Wheeler, single seater type vehicles or motorkhana specials are not permitted without the prior approval of the Event Secretary or the Clerk of the Course. Electric vehicles not allowed at this Event

27. Passengers:

(Reference “Motorkhana Standing Regulations” – Section 9 – Passengers)

A passenger is permitted for the purpose of instruction / guidance subject to the following:

- **All persons participating as a passenger must complete a “Passenger in vehicle Disclaimer” Form prior to the event.**
 - This **must** be submitted to the Secretary of the Event via email at eventsec@nsw.mx5.au
- An inexperienced Driver may carry an experienced Passenger for instruction or guidance purposes.
- An experienced Driver may carry an inexperienced Passenger.
 - Exception: A Junior Driver must be accompanied only by a Parent or Guardian.
- Only 1 Passenger is permitted in the Automobile with the Driver at any time during a Test.
- Each Passenger must wear apparel and use a seat belt compliant with Technical Appendix Schedule D and I.
